This pass will allow youth unlimited rides on SCPT routes this summer to get to employment, social activities and events. The pass will be available for purchase beginning May 17th. Working in Albany? Perhaps you are not aware that our commuter service into Albany can save you money and eliminate parking hassles. With our new consolidated commuter route schedule which took effect April 5, we can take you to many destinations including the State Office Campus and the Empire State Plaza. Would you like to go to Crossgates or Colonie Center on a Saturday or Sunday without the hassle of traffic and parking? Our bus leaves Cobleskill at noon and drops you off at the door to the mall. There is plenty of time for shopping, and lunch before the bus leaves Albany at 6:00 pm to return to Cobleskill. The fare is only \$8.50 for the round trip! We are now operating Route 2A which begins running at Price Chopper at 2:50 pm through the village of Cobleskill. The route ends at 8:55 pm with the final stop at Price Chopper. This route will remain in effect throughout the summer months.
