

SUNY COBLESKILL FIGHTING TIGER WEEKLY RECAP 4/12/21

The SUNY Cobleskill men's baseball team posted a sweep over Cazenovia College in the team's opening North Atlantic Conference (NAC) doubleheader of the season defeating the host Wildcats on Saturday by scores of 10-9 and 15-1. Junior outfielder Nick Thomas, Scotia, N.Y., Scotia-Glenville High School/Hudson Valley Community College, was 5-for-9 on the afternoon with two home runs, four runs scored and three RBI as the Fighting Tigers moved to 3-1 overall including a 2-0 mark in conference action.

The Fighting Tiger women's softball team split four games during the week sweeping Alfred State College on Tuesday at home by scores of 11-6 and 10-8 then falling twice at Cazenovia College on Saturday in NAC play by identical scores of 6-4 and 6-4 to move their season record to 2-4 overall including a 0-2 mark in conference play. Sophomore centerfielder Jillian Nitchman, Ballston Spa, N.Y., Ballston Spa High School, batted .428 on the week for Cobleskill with a home run, a triple, seven RBI and a pair of runs scored.

The Cobleskill women's volleyball team took to the road on Sunday afternoon to take a pair of matches from the host Wildcats of Cazenovia College coming from behind to win the first match 3-2 by set scores of 18-25, 15-25, 25-21, 25-23 and 15-8 then winning the closing contest 3-2 by set scores of 20-25, 25-14, 25-6, 21-25 and 15-11. With the victories the Fighting Tigers are now 2-2 overall on the year to date. Cobleskill was led by freshman outside hitter Mackenzie Larson, Winterset, lowa, Winterset High School, who averaged 3.8 kills, 2.3 digs and 1.0 service aces in 10 sets played on the afternoon.
