SUNY Cobleskill men's outdoor track & field team senior jumper Tyler Brado, St. Johnsville, N.Y., Oppenhein-Ephratah-St. Johnsville High School, turned in the team's top overall performance at the 2021 Bronco Weekend Classic hosted by SUNY Delhi in Delhi, N.Y. over the weekend, The Fighting Tiger senior won the high jump with an effort by clearing a height of 2.01 meters (6'7") to meet the 2021 NCAA Division III Outdoor Track & Field National Championship Meet qualifying standard. With his mark, Brado is currently ranked fifth in the NCAA Division III Atlantic Region in the event.

The Cobleskill baseball split a pair of North Atlantic Conference (NAC) contests with Western Division rival SUNY Polytechnic Institute on Sunday winning the first game in extra innings by a score of 5-2 in the first game then losing the nightcap by a 12-7 margin. With the split the Fighting Tigers move to 12-7 overall including a 10-4 conference record to clench a spot in the NAC Western Division Championship series. Junior right fielder Samuel Gutierrez, Bayside, N.Y., Martin Van Buren High School/Queensborough Community College, hit a walk-off three run homer in the first game in extra innings to give the Orange & Black the victory.

Four members of the Fighting Tiger women's softball team were honored by the North Atlantic Conference (NAC) with 2021 post season honors by the league. Sophomore centerfielder Jillian Nitchman, Ballston Spa, N.Y., Ballston Spa High School, was named to the league's First Team, sophomore catcher Ashley Covert, Castile, N.Y., Letchworth High School, was named to the league's Second Team and senior shortstop Megan Gilligan, East Chatham, N.Y., Chatham High School, was named as an Honorable Mention. Senior utility player/pitcher Edyliese Aquino, Stamford, Conn., Westhill High School, also earned NAC honors after being named to the conference's Sportsmanship Team for her efforts during the year.

Sophomore distance runner Shania Steria, Booneville, N.Y., Adirondack High School, turned in the women's outdoor team's top effort at the 2021 Bronco Weekend Classic hosted by SUNY Delhi in Delhi, N.Y. over the weekend. The Fighting Tiger sophomore placed second overall in the 800-meter run with a time of 3:05.89 at the event.
