## Veterinary services coordinated by Cobleskill Veterinary Clinic

Proof of previous vaccination must be shown at time of the clinic for animal to receive 3-year certificate.

- · Vaccinations available free of charge.
- Donations to offset clinic expenses are appreciated.
- Animals must be at least 3 months of age. Do not bring any ill animals.
- Animals must be properly restrained, or they will not be vaccinated.
- Cats and ferrets must be brought in a carrier or a well-sealed, sturdy container.
- Local organizations provide their facilities for your convenience. It is your responsibility to clean up after your pet. It's the law and you can be fined.
