## **SUNY COBLESKILL** **FIGHTING TIGER WEEKLY RECAP 9/20/21**

The SUNY Cobleskill men's cross country team captured their third consecutive invitational win on Saturday afternoon posting a team score of 19 points to outrun a six-team field at the 2021 Wildcat Invitational hosted by SUNY Polytechnic Institute on the Wildcats home course in Marcy, N.Y. First-year runner Eamonn Sullivan, Wappingers Falls, N.Y., Fordham Preparatory School, out-distanced the 55-runner field at the event by completing the 8000-meter course in a time of 26:29.2.

The Fighting Tiger women's volleyball team won three-of four non-league home matches during the week losing to Russell Sage College 3-2 on Tuesday by scores of: 25-18, 21-25, 14-25, 25-9 and 8-15 then defeating Bay Path University on Thursday 3-0 by set scores of: 25-13, 25-14 and 25-11. Cobleskill closed the week by sweeping a triangular match on Saturday defeating Keuka College 3-2 by scores of: 25-20, 25-22, 21-25, 16-25 and 15-5, before downing Mitchell College 3-1 by scores of: 25-16, 25-20, 23-25 and 25-22 to improve to 3-8 overall on the season. Sophomore outside hitter MacKenzie Larson, Winterset, Iowa, Winterset High School, led the way for the Orange & Black averaging 2.9 kills, 3.4 digs and 1.1 service aces for the week.

Running as an individual Fighting Tiger senior runner Gabriella Decker, Galway, N.Y., Galway High School, was the Fighting Tiger women's cross country team's top finisher at the 2021 Wildcat Invitational hosted by SUNY Polytechnic Institute on the Wildcats home course in Marcy, N.Y. Decker placed 27th overall by completing the 6000-meter course in a time of 38:29.6.

The men's golf team had a busy week traveling to New Hartford, N.Y. on Thursday to place fourth in a field of four teams with a total score of 125-over par 409 at the 2021 Utica College Fall Invitational hosted by the Pioneers at the par 71/ 6792-yard Yahnudasis Golf Club. The Fighting Tigers then posted a team total of 119-over-par 407 to place sixth in a field of six teams at the 2021 Lou Jarvis Memorial Tournament hosted by Northern Vermont University- Johnson on Saturday at the par 72/6874-yard Jay Peak Resort Golf Club in Jay, Vt. Senior Ethan Straub, Oswego, N.Y., Oswego High School/Onondaga Community College, was the team's top finisher during the week firing a score of three-over par-75 to pace third in a field of 28 players at the tournament.

The Fighting Tiger men' soccer team lost a pair of home contests over the weekend falling to North Atlantic Conference (NAC) rival SUNY Canton in double overtime by a 2-1 margin prior to dropping a 4-0 non-conference home contest to SUNY Maritime on Sunday. First-year forward Cater Ciavardoni, Latham, N.Y., Shaker High School, scored the lone Cobleskill goal on Saturday for the Orange & Black.
