

# Public Service Announcement

## THE CHENANGO COUNTY LOCAL LAW

**NO. 2 OF 1997 STATES:** “During the period of November 1st of each calendar year through April 15th of the next succeeding calendar year, no person, persons, corporation, business, partnership, company of other entity shall park or suffer the parking of motor vehicle on Chenango County highways, roadways, shoulders or right of way from the hours of 11:00 pm through 7:00 am.”

Any such vehicle in violation of this law shall be issued a “Notice of Violation” and be fined not exceeding two hundred and fifty dollars (\$250.00) or by imprisonment not exceeding fifteen (15) days, or both.

Also, under Highway Law 2, Section 214: “Any person who shall deposit...upon a highway...snow, ice...shall be liable to a penalty...”

It is against highway law to allow snow to be placed upon a highway. Also, when you hire someone to plow snow from your driveway be sure they do not push the snow across the roadway. By doing this they leave a deposit of snow in the road. You are responsible for creating a hazard for the motoring public. Please be respectful of other people.
