What's not covered by Medicare Part A & Part B? Medicare doesn't cover everything. Some of the items and services Medicare doesn't cover include:

- Long-Term Care (also called custodial care)
- Most dental care
- Eye exams related to prescribing glasses
- Dentures
- Cosmetic surgery
- Acupuncture
- Hearing aids and exams for fitting them
- Routine foot care

If you need services Medicare doesn't cover, you'll have to pay for them yourself unless you have other insurance or a Medicare health plan that covers them. If you're not lawfully present in the U.S., Medicare won't pay for your Part A and Part B claims, and you can't enroll in a Medicare Advantage Plan or a Medicare drug plan.

Join **EPIC** to save more with Medicare Part D. The Elderly Pharmaceutical Insurance Coverage program saves you more money on the cost of your prescription drugs by supplementing your Medicare Part D plan. To receive EPIC benefits, you must be enrolled in a Part D plan. Who can join? A resident of New York State 65 or older with annual income up to \$75,000 if single or \$100,00 if married. An eligible senior with a Medicaid spend down not receiving full Medicaid benefits. EPIC provides seniors with co-payment assistance for Medicare Part D covered prescription drugs after any Part D deductible is met. EPIC also covers many Medicare Part D excluded drugs.
