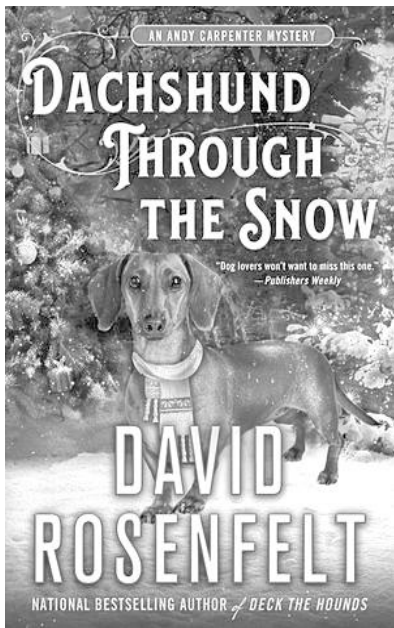


Guernsey Book Lovers
