

Rogers Center to Host Seeds of Community Wildflower Planting

Celebrate Earth Day by planting native wildflowers at Rogers Center and at home! On Saturday, April 26th, the public is invited to Sherburne to plant an assortment of seeds which will expand pollinator habitat around the Rogers Center Three Sisters Garden. The planting will begin at 10:30 am across the street from the visitor parking lot, at 2721 NY-80. Participants can sow the upturned earth and make their own 'bloom bundles' with paper pulp and wildflower seeds to take home and share with others.
