From blues to Tex-Mex to rock-n-roll – it's all there. Preceding them on the Infield Stage are Joanne Shaw Taylor, DK Harrell and Kenny "Blues Boss" Wayne. The Tent Stage is similarly stacked with blues rocker Ally Venable, gospel icons The Legendary Ingramettes, supergroup DeSoto Tigers Testimony and Chris Thomas King. The days action kicks off at a new early start time of 11:00 A.M. with Tom Townsleys tribute to Chess Records with Jess Sheldon taking a guest turn.
