### EVENT OVERVIEW

Part of the local commemorations of America250, a national initiative centered around the 250th anniversary of the founding of the United States, this free family festival features "America's Potluck" and an outdoor performance spectacle which brings the Haudenosaunee Creation Story to life. The "Turtle Island" experience features a giant inflatable puppet, the Sky Woman Iroquois Dance Theater, and traditional Indigenous music to depict the birth of the world on a turtle's back. "America's Potluck" is an opportunity for neighbors to join one another to share a communal meal, creating a sense of connection and belonging and fostering interactions among people from all walks of life.
